Thank you for the clarification. Indeed, the 3 weeks delay is very short.

Do you think it is possible to send the cells before November 21, as a maximum deadline?

I'm asking you this question because we plan to travel several weeks with the prototypes to test the material far from home, and the plane is scheduled for November 24... in the short term, we must get these cells before this date.

If this time is too short for production, then I think it is more reasonable to buy some oxygen cells elsewhere, and come back to you in a few months to start testing.

On the other hand, if it is possible to ship before November 21, then go ahead :)
