

STORAGE, HANDLING & APPLICATION

1. STORAGE For optimal storage conditions, maintain a cool, dry environment with temperatures ranging

between 20 to 25°C and a relative humidity of 40-50%. Stack reels vertically to prevent distortion of the core.

Store the items in cardboard boxes until they are ready for use, and ensure they are shielded

from direct sunlight.

To manage inventory effectively, rotate stocks regularly, prioritizing the use of the oldest items

first.

When required, repackage partially used reels into their original packaging for secure storage.

2. HANDLING Remember all reels are most vulnerable on edges so handle gently.

Rough handling can cause 'nicking' and eventual web break on applicator machines.

3. APPLICATION The following is a list of surfaces to which it is diffiult to obtain satisfactory adhesion:

P.I.F.E., untreated polygelatins, silcone treated or contaminated surfaces,

surfaces chemically treated, waxed surfaces, printed polyethylene, rough surfaces, ie: wood, metal, weaved fabric, moist or cold surfaces, surfaces with condensate bloom, irregular shaped surfaces, dusty surfaces, surfaces where adhesive may be significantly

exposed to atmosphere.
