I've checked with Production and I see what has happened. The device was last tested in July as part of a larger batch, whereas we usually try to leave them almost complete and finish off the QA at the last moment to ensure a more recent calibration.

If you can send it back to us, we will be happy to offer you a free of charge calibration check, which will reset the calibration date.

You can take advantage of that now if it makes it more convenient, but it might be wise to send it back in July. Just let me know when you want to return it and I will send you the returns reference number and further instructions.

Thank you for your email. We would be happy to provide a V1000 on Sale or Return, for you to trial.

Please find attached our 'Sale or Return' Terms & Conditions Form, which will need to be completed by an authorised person within the Trust; it differs from Trust to Trust but this will usually be Procurement or any person responsible for organising loan equipment and/or trials.

Please can you return the form to me (a picture or scan attached to an email is fine but a fax is also acceptable), and can you also confirm a specific delivery address complete with department and contact details of the person that will accept responsibility for receiving and returning the goods, usually a senior member of Clinical Engineering.
