Your request was forwarded to me as in order to provide you with the pricing that you need, we need some additional information.

The situation is a bit complicated as the Aeonmed vents that were supplied to the UK as part of the COVID-19 response came with contradictory information regarding which sensors are compatible. So far, we have confirmed **at least 3 different sensors** in use, I have listed them below with links to our website. As these are all different specifications and connectors, we really need to know which sensors are currently installed:

- MOX-4 / compatible to **Teledyne T-7**
