Thank you for the new order and for the associated documentation.

1) **Purchase order.** The price stated is £51.00, but for a batch quantity of 60 it should be £54.00 each. Our price list is based on batch quantities.

Our prices are EXW

The delivery date of the 29/10/21 is tight, we will get back to you later this week with an update.

FYI our part number for the sensors is 8010050

2) **Call-off order.** The one from last year was provided by Duncan to provide us with an annual quantity, so that we can endeavour to ensure that we have sufficient components stock in the pipeline.

The invoiced price is governed by the batch quantity purchase order.

3) Again, the standard JFD Ts&Cs have been supplied.

They are not completely applicable, for example:

- a) We can't supply against these as the payment terms should be 30 days.
- b) Section 8 is not applicable...
- 4) We will supply sensors against our specification. As discussed, several times previously we do not have the abilities to test or guarantee the magnetic signature <3.5nT.

Application specific components Low/non-magnetic components utilized: Cathode, internal wiring. Suitability and QA assessment to be carried out by JFD prior to sensor production.

5) Sensor life is as per our specifications:

Nominal sensor life 500,000 % oxygen hours Typical sensor life 20 to 24 months from date of invoice (including shelf life).
