


MULTI-CHAIR



Assembly Instructions

For Seat, Stand and Swing

MS 1150

Read instructions carefully.

Do not leave baby unattended. Always ensure the product is on a level, stable surface.


Please ensure all hazardous items such as knives, toasters, kettles and flexes are out of your child's reach.


Your seat will arrive packed flat.


Although a waist strap and crotch strap are provided with the highchair we also recommend the use of a separate British Standard Approved Safety Harness (BS 6684). Simply secure the harness by clipping the attachment hook to the Drings, which are to be found on each side of the waist strap harness.


- (1) Open stand.
- (2) Press down side locks.
- (3) Locate slots (in seat back) onto stand hooks as shown.
- 4 Slacken adjustment knobs and pull the seat frame up under the crosswire. To secure seat, retighten knobs.
- 5) Assemble stand for swing. Press down side locks.
- (6) Lift crosswire and lock behind swing hooks.
- Attach cords as shown.
- Your assembled chair should look like this.
- (9) Attach cord rings to hooks as shown.
- (10) Ensure frame is adjusted as shown and knobs are tight.
- To convert to low chair, slacken knobs and pull the tutular frame down.
- Tighten both adjusting knobs in a clockwise direction before placing baby in seat.
- The seat is fully adjustable from the upright position for the older child to the lower position for the younger child.
- (14) (15) The Multi-Chair can also be used as a feeding chair. Place baby into seat and fasten safety harness provided and insert the ends C of the tray into slots D ensuring the clips E go into slots F.



GUIDELINES

The following guidelines have been written to enable you to get the best from your new product.

 Clean all areas regularly with a mild soap and warm water solution. Do not use harsh abrasives or strong detergents. Do not use polish.

 All fabrics should be dried thoroughly before storage. Failure to do this could result in forming on the fabric. Do not store in a damp environment.

 All parts of Maclaren products can be replaced. In the event of accidental damage please contact your nearest authorised Maclaren Service Agent, who will be able to assist you. (List enclosed).

4. Regular servicing extends the life of any product. Contact your Service Agent for advice.

Regularly inspect your highchair and ensure all components are securely fixed and have not worn unduly. Check the swing cords and fixings and replace as necessary.

Check that the locking mechanisms are free to move and function correctly.


Do not use lubricants of any kind.

Do not make any adjustments to this high chair other than are detailed.

Do not use the rear of the seat unit as a carrying handle. Always use part of the metal frame when carrying your highchair.

The maximum weight of a child using the swing should be 9kg up to an age of 6 months.

TO ASSEMBLE THE HIGHCHAIR

- Open the stand.
- 2 IMPORTANT Press both of the side locks fully down to lock out the frame.
- 3 Locate the lower slots in the seat back onto the stand hooks, and ensure the crosswire is in the lower position.
- 4 Slacken the adjustment knobs, and pull the seat frame up under the crosswire. Retighten the knobs, to secure the seat in position.

TO ASSEMBLE THE SWING.

Press down the stand side locks (fig 2).

- 5 Lift the crosswire and lock behind the swing hooks.
- Attach cords to the wires at the front and through the slots in the seat back.
- Attach the cord rings to the hooks as shown. Ensure the cord is not twisted, and that the seat swings freely and centrally between the frame.
- 8 Ensure the frame is adjusted as shown and knobs are tight.

TO CONVERT TO A LOW CHAIR

- 9 Slacken the knobs and pull the tubular frame down.
- Tighten both knobs in a clockwise direction before placing the baby in the seat.
- The seat is fully adjustable from the upright position for the older child to the lower position for the younger child.
- 12 The Multi-Chair can also be used as a feeding chair.
 - Place baby into seat and fasten safety harness provided.
 - Insert the ends of the tray (C) through the holes in the cover fabric, and into the slots (D), ensuring clips (E) go into slots (F).
 - Push the tray fully home to secure it.

HARNESS OPERATION

13 Insert the clasp (item D) through the crotch strap (item B).

To fasten the lap strap, insert the fastener (item C) into the clasp (item D), ensuring that the button clicks into position. To attach the shoulder harness (item E) attach clips (item F) to the clasp and fastener (items C and D). Each lap strap has its own length adjuster (item G).


To undo the lap strap, press the fastener button, push forward to release the lip then separate the clasp and fastener.

To adjust the height of the shoulder harness position unthread it through the cover and seat back and refit it through the selected slots.

'D' rings (item H) are provided for fitting an additional harness.


SEAT COVER


The cover fabric can be removed for washing. Refer to the care label. Remove the tray, and unclip the harness. Remove the cover carefully unthreading the harness through the holes in the cover. To refi the cover, reverse the above procedure.



Always use the 5 point harness, correctly fitted and adjusted. Children should not be left unattended in this product.
Children should always wear the harness, correctly fitted and adjusted.
Do not make adjustments whilst the baby is in the seat.
When in use always ensure the surface you place it on is firm and level.
Ensure all hazardous items such as knives, toasters, kettles, and flexes are out of your child's reach.

Clean all surfaces regularly with a mild soap and warm water solution. Do not use harsh abrasives or strong detergents. Do not use polish. All fabrics should be washed according to the care label and should be dried thoroughly before storage to prevent the formation of mildew. Do not store in a damp place.

Regular servicing will extend the life of the product. Contact your Service Agent for advice.

Regularly inspect your multi chair and ensure all components are securely fixed and have not worn unduly. Check the swing cords and fixing for wear or fretting and replace as necessary.

Check that the locking mechanisms are free to move and function correctly.

Do not use lubricants of any kind.

Do not make any adjustments to this Multi Chair other than are detailed. Do not use the rear of the seat unit as a carrying handle. Always use part of the metal frame when carrying your high chair.

When using the swing facility, place the stand on a level floor, not on a raised surface. Supervision must be by an adult. The maximum weight of a child using the swing should be 9kg (20lbs).

Use only genuine Maclaren Replacement parts.

The Multi Chair must not be used for the transport of a baby in a car.

Although a safety harness is provided with the Multi Chair we recommend the use of a separate safety harness (to BS 6684). Simply secure the harress by clipping the attachment hook to the 'D' rings, which are to be found on each side of the waist strap harness.
