Most council tax bills provide 10 instalments from April to January. If you prefer, you can pay your bill over 12 monthly instalments. To benefit from 12 instalments in the council tax year 2022/23 you must contact Customer Services by 15 April 2022. After this date it may not be possible to pay your bill over 12 months in this financial year.

If your bill already shows 12 instalments, you need take no further action.

Instalments are due on 1st of each month or you can choose the 20th of the month if paying by Direct Debit. Please ensure payments are made on or before the dates shown overleaf. If payments are not made by the due date you may lose the right to pay by instalments, meaning that you will have to pay the remaining instalment amounts immediately.

Council tax exemptions and discounts

Certain types of properties and groups of people are eligible for discounts or exemptions on council tax e.g. properties which are left empty by people receiving care or students. There are also reductions available on application for some physical and mental disabilities. See our website for further details and how to apply - www.cravendc.gov.uk

Council tax reduction

Council tax reduction (CTR) is a means tested reduction to your council tax liability, intended to help lower income households. The amount of CTR on your bill is the calculated amount for the full financial year. If you would like to know how your entitlement has been assessed, you can request a more detailed calculation statement. If you think the assessment is incorrect you can appeal and the decision will be looked at again and a detailed explanation issued. If you think the council's decision is wrong, or you don't hear back within 2 months, you can appeal to the Valuation Tribunal. You must appeal within 2 months of the council telling you its decision or 4 months of you first writing to the council (if you haven't had a response).

Energy Rebate

If you pay by direct debit, and your dwelling is in Band A-D, you may receive a payment of £150. The grant is awarded on the assumption that, as at 1st April 2022, the recipient is the liable council tax payer for the property, which must be an occupied property in Bands A-D. If the recipient is found not to have been eligible for the grant the payment may be liable for recovery. Only one payment may be made to a property (the grant is provided to support all residents of the household).

Your responsibilities

If you are receiving CTR, a discount or exemption you must inform the council within 21 days if circumstances change which might affect entitlement. Making a false statement or failing to declare a change which affects entitlement could result in a financial penalty or prosecution.

Adult Social Care

The Secretary of State made an offer to adult social care authorities. The offer was the option of an adult social care authority being able to charge an additional "precept" on its council tax without holding a referendum, to assist the authority in meeting its expenditure on adult social care from the financial year 2016-17.

It was originally made in respect of the financial years up to and including 2019-20. If the Secretary of State chooses to renew this offer in respect of a particular financial year, this is subject to the approval of the House of Commons. This additional precept has been approved for 2022/23.

Direct Debit

Cash payments are no longer accepted at any of the Council's Offices and will only be accepted at Post Offices and PayPoint outlets provided you have an Allpay card.
