

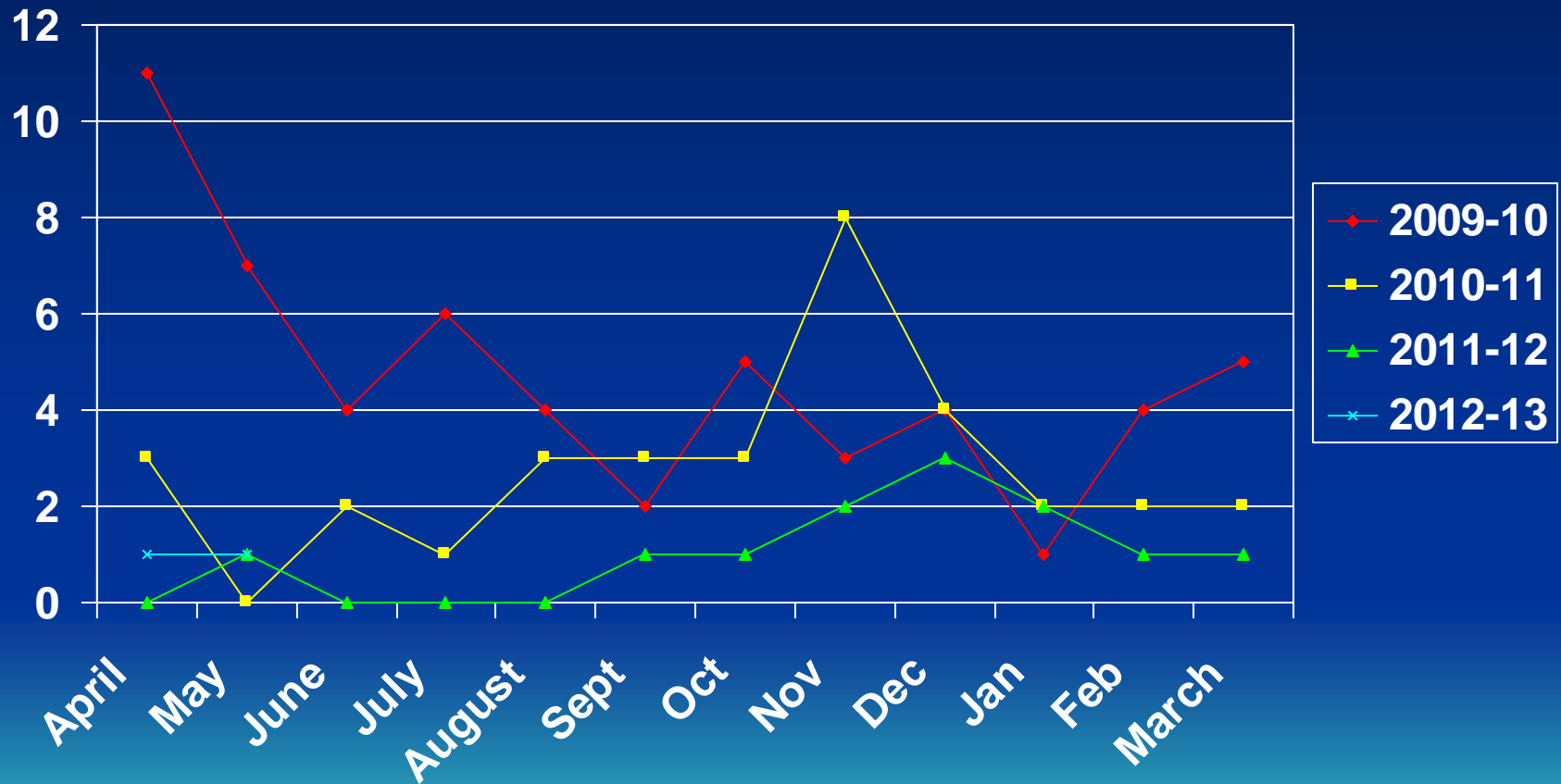


So Who are we

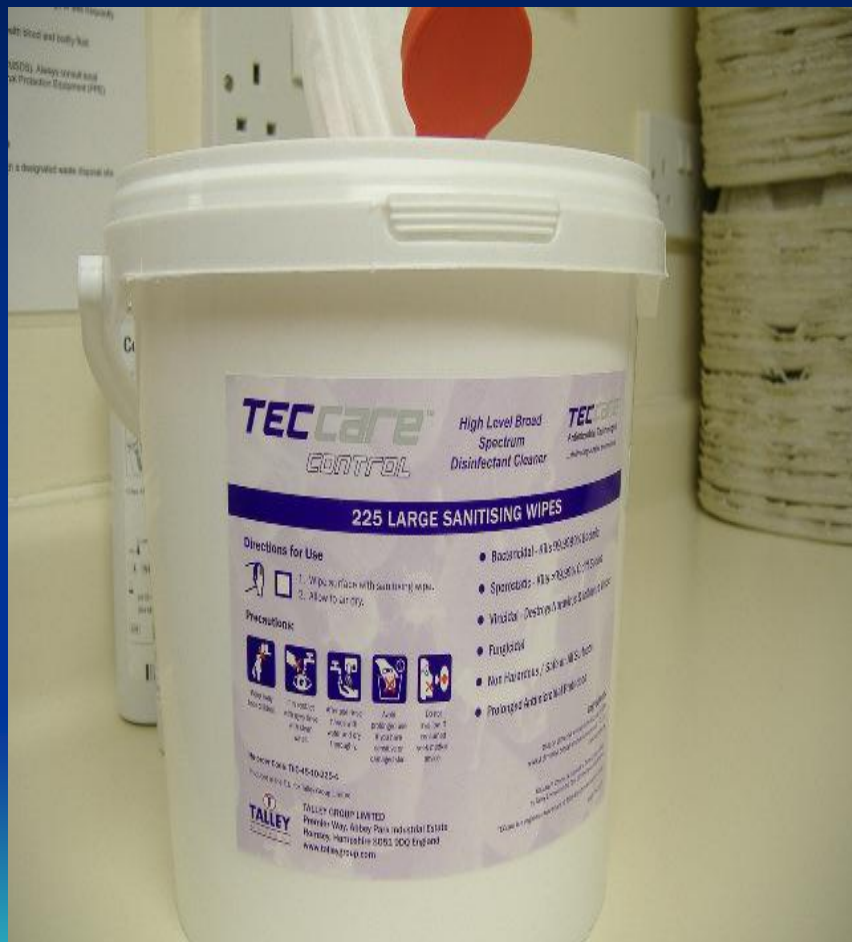
