

House to house questionnaire re burglary at 3 Anderton Street

Information for occupier

Around 3:00pm to 4:00pm on the afternoon of Tuesday 2nd July, a male knocked on the back door of number 3 Anderton Street. The elderly female occupant has answered the door and the man has asked her for money. He is described as 18 - 19 years old, tall and thin. The man has entered the house whilst the occupant has got her purse. The man has grabbed the purse from the occupant and in the process has pushed her to the floor before making his escape. The lady has fortunately only suffered bruising to her arm and shoulder as a result. The purse is described a blue, with a metal clasp and a zip on the side, approximately 3" x 5", it contained a quantity of loose change.
