

Chemical Requirements Declaration of Compliance

Viamed Ltd (Supplier) and any products delivered by Viamed to Masimo Sweden AB, part no: 0000-1794 / product 4420613, 0000-6560 / product 4420616, 0000-8179 / product 4420614 (Products), will comply with all laws applicable to the products, including, without limitation, the following specific regulations:

- REACH: Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals;
- RoHS: Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment;
- POPs: Regulation (EC) No 850/2004 on Persistent Organic Pollutants;
- Prohibition of DEHP under French law.

- A. RoHS – Supplier must inform Masimo if any exemptions under Annex III and IV to the Directive have been applied to any of the supplied Products.
- B. Candidate List – Supplier must inform Masimo if the Products contain any substances on the REACH Candidate List (Article 33) of substances of very high concern (SVHC) at a concentration above 0.1 % (weight by weight). Immediately after any substance is included in the Candidate List of SVHC, Supplier must provide enough information to Masimo to allow safe use of the applicable Products, including the chemical name of the substance, including for any assembled Products, the concentration limit of each part individually.
- C. Restriction and Authorisation Lists – Supplier must inform Masimo in a timely manner of any updates to the REACH Restriction List (Annex XVII) and Authorisation List (Annex XIV) 120 days before those updates go into effect. If a concerned substance is present in any Product, Supplier must inform Masimo about the presence of the substance and cooperate with Masimo to find a replacement solution.
- D. DEHP – Because of the ban in France beginning 1 July 2015 of using DEHP in certain medical devices, Supplier must inform Masimo if there is any DEHP in any of the Products, above 0%, and cooperate with Masimo to find a replacement solution at least 90 days before the ban goes into effect.


