

- Wall mounted radiant warmer on articulated arm
- Tom Thumb Infant Resuscitation Unit
- Low suction controller
- Vacsax suction receiving system, utilising disposable liners
- Resuscitation platform manufactured from waterproof construction board
- Wide bed (35cm), to allow easy access to the patient and prevent mattress movement
- Sealed mattress manufactured to BS5852 (Crib5) standards
- Digital Apgar timer, audible indications at 1, 5 and 10-minutes
- Storage bins
- Air/Oxygen Blender (optional) to allow delivery of blended gases from 21% to 100% oxygen
