**A6068 MAIN STREET, GLUSBURN – ROAD CLOSURES FOR CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING**

This letter is to inform you that North Yorkshire County Council will be undertaking highway maintenance at the above location, on the A6068 Main Street between Garden Close (West of the Institute) and East of Station Road, including small sections of Wheatlands Lane, Holme Lane and Station Road.

The works will be split into three main sections:

1. A6068 from Garden Close (West of Institute) to the Police Station: Road Closed 19:00 to midnight; 5<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> September excluding Friday 9<sup>th</sup>, Sat. 10<sup>th</sup> and Sun. 11<sup>th</sup>
2. A6068 from Wheatlands Lane to Holme Lane (including Wheatlands Lane but not including Holme Lane): Road Closed 19:00 to midnight; 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> September inclusive.
3. A6068 from Holme Lane to Station Road, including Holme Lane and Station Road: Road Closed 19:00 to midnight; 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> September inclusive.

In addition Station Road will be closed on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> September to carry out some drainage and kerbing work.

The work is part of an extensive programme and as a consequence it is possible that some adjustment to this start date or the duration of the works may be necessary should unforeseen circumstances such as significant weather events or emergencies on the highway network arise.

The road closures will inevitably restrict vehicular access to properties directly affected but our contractors will try to assist you where possible during the working period through the use of on-site personnel tasked with managing access. Access will be provided wherever possible. If you require access to your property, then please approach the on-site personnel for assistance. Please be advised there may be extended periods when access will just not be possible due to the nature of the works and physical constraints of the site. Pedestrian access will be permitted but only at times when it is safe to do so. We request your assistance in the following ways:-

- Please do not park your vehicle on the A6068 or other areas where work is due to take place;
- Please cooperate and comply with any instructions issued by the traffic management operatives and take extra care whilst within the works area.

A plan showing the extent of the works is shown on the back of this letter, for your information.

I would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any disruption that these works may cause and would again request your cooperation to help ensure an efficiently and safely executed project.
